## at the Great Arizona Puppet Theater I will...

- 1** Look for different kinds of puppets. Puppets can be operated in different ways. Look at the puppets in the Exhibit. Puppets that move with strings are called string puppets or marionettes. How many marionettes can you count in the Exhibit?
- 2** Guess what stories the puppets in the Exhibit could tell. Many of the Exhibits have scripts in them - see if you are right!
- 3** After the puppet show, talk about it. What happened first? Then what happened? How did the puppet show end? What was your favorite part?
- 4** Draw a picture of the puppet show. Post it on the Great Arizona Puppet Theater Facebook page.
- 5** Make your own puppet! Make a paper bag puppet at the puppet making table. Ideas are up on the wall, but you can make whatever you want.
